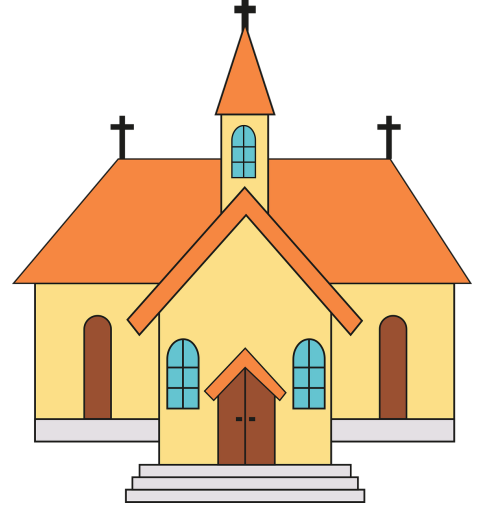


WHISPER CREEK CHAPEL

OUR PURPOSE is to offer Whisper Creek residents the opportunity to gather with people in our park, to worship our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, and enjoy Christian fellowship, glorifying God in all that we say and do.

WE OPERATE by established guidelines which are followed by elected officers that form our Chapel Committee. We are non-denominational, and we have an “in-park” retired Pastor and use other local pastors when needed. Chapel begins in January and continues through the month of March.

WHAT WE DO is sing praises to God, read selected Scriptures, pray, enjoy special music from residents, and hear a great message from God’s Word. We share prayer requests, and acknowledge birthdays and anniversaries. The first Sunday of the month we partake in Communion. Once a month we also enjoy fellowship with coffee and donuts following our worship service.

OUTREACH OPPORTUNITIES in the past have been that we provided a Bake Sale during the Springfest Craft show at the beginning of March. Proceeds and most of our offerings go to the Salvation Army which we have given generously to.

SERVICE OPPORTUNITIES include greeting people as they arrive, reading Scripture, singing alone or with a group, playing an instrument, and helping with our outreach events.

A weekly offering is collected to cover expenses, compensate our Pastor or Guest pastor, and to meet other Chapel needs. Monies not used will also be added to our selected charity at the season’s end.
